Day 1: Read Verses 7:1-13

1. Look up these references to the Jewish Feast of Tabernacles & record your findings:

Exodus 23:16 -Exodus 34:22 -Leviticus 23:34-43 Numbers 29:12-40 Deuteronomy 16:13-15 Ezra 3:4 Nehemiah 8:13-18

- 2. What was the real message the brothers were saying to Jesus?
- 3. Can you compare today how Christians also fear saying anything in public with verse 13?

Day 2: Verses 7:14-34

- 4. What did Jesus do halfway through the festival?
- 5. How did Jesus admonish the crowd?
- 6. In verses 33-34, what is Jesus referring to?

Day 3: Verses 7:35-44

- 7. Look up Colossions 3:11 as you read verse 35. Who are the Greeks referred here?
- 8. Expand on the statement, "rivers of living water" and what this means in your life.
- 9. Verses 41-44 show the confusion of the people regarding who Jesus was. Where did they think Jesus was from and why?

Day 4: 7:45-52

10. How did the guards respond when questioned by the chief priest and Pharisees?
11. Verse 49 says the mob knows nothing of the law. What do you think this statement meant?
12. How does Nicodemus step in?
13. With Nicodemus stepping in, what does this say regarding him at this point?
Day 5: Reflection
14. Jesus taught with authority. With what authority do you have to teach others about Him? See Matthew 28:18-20 to help you.
15. Like the people who were divided in their belief or unbelief about Jesus, are there areas of unbelief you need to seek out? If so, how will you do this?'
16. In this lesson, Jesus taught with authority and preached with passion. What does this mean to you as a follower of Him?
17. Sum up this lesson by creating a 10 word sentence that describes this entire lesson.
