4. How was the question by the Pharisees a trap? Expand on this a bit.
5. Why do you think Jesus began writing in the dirt?
6. How Jesus responds to the accusation of the woman affect you? What does this say about Jesus' heart?

### Day 3: Verses 8:10-11

7. What is the significance in verse 9 of those who were the oldest left first?
8. Look up the word "condemn" and record your finding:
9. When Jesus said he did not condemn the woman, how does this touch your heart regarding what He has done for your personal sins?

### Day 4: 8:12-30

10. Explain in your own words how Jesus turned their argument around regarding witnesses:

11. Why do you think they asked Jesus where His Father was?

12. What does it mean to die in your sin?

13. How is your thinking challenged by Jesus' statement of "doing what pleases His Father"?

**Day 5: Reflection**

14. Jesus' example toward the adulterous woman is one of grace. What does grace mean to you?

15. Discuss a time when you have been condemned by others.

16. In verses 12-30, Jesus logically defends who He and His Father are. Using your own logic, what do you tell others regarding your own faith?
