

## EXHALE Bible Discovery ~ John Chapter 6:1-24

### Day 1: Read Verses 6:1-9

1. Where was Jesus now & what feast was near?
2. Which disciple did Jesus ask the question of where to buy bread for the people?
3. Why do you think Jesus was testing this disciple?

### Day 2: Verses 6:10-15

4. Look up Mark 6:30-32. This gives a bit more insight to where Jesus & His disciples were prior to the miracle of the feeding of the 5,000. What do you learn in the Mark verses that are significant?
5. The feeding of the 5,000 is mentioned in all 4 of the Gospels. Take some notes on each one:

Matthew 14:15-21

Mark 6:35-44

Luke 9:12-17

6. Why do you think Jesus had them gather up the leftover pieces so nothing was wasted?

### Day 3: Verses 6:16-21

7. Go to Matthew 14:22-23. Why did Jesus send the disciples ahead of Himself?
8. What do you think the significance of the disciples being about 3.5 miles out on the lake?
9. As Jesus approaches them on the water, He assures them it is He. In the Matthew version (14:27-33) of this miracle, he tells about Peter's response. What lessons do you learn from Peter's experience?

## Day 4: 6:22-24

10. What did the crowd realize about Jesus?

11. Like the crowds, are you searching for Jesus as your daily bread? How?

12. In Mark 6:54-56, how did the people react to Jesus being there?

## Day 5: Reflection

13. In verses 6:1-15, we see Jesus' miracle by food! He provided for the people. How is He providing for you today and in your life?

14. What are you doing in your life to “not waste” the gifts He has given you?

15. In the verses 6:16-24, Jesus showed a miracle on foot! What storms in your life are you entrusting to Him?

16. What are you doing to keep your eyes on Jesus like Peter did to keep from sinking?

17. What was your main takeaway from this week's lesson? How is this study impacting your life?

18. Sum up this lesson by creating a 10 word sentence that describes this entire lesson.
