Day 2: Verses 6:35-42

4. Who is the bread of life? What is His promise to those who come to Him?
5. What is the Father's will?
6. What did the Jews begin to grumble about?
7. What are you grumbling about?

Day 3: Verses 6:43-59

8. What does Jesus mean when He said, "no one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him."?
9. Have you been drawn to Jesus? How do you know?
10. In verses 53-58, Jesus explains the doctrine of eating His flesh & drinking His blood. What future event is this pointing?

Day 4: 6:60-71

11. What happened to many of Jesus' disciples after hearing the words in verses 53-58?

12. How does Jesus expand on this teaching in verses 61-64?

13. Jesus clearly states in verse 65 that no one can come unless the Father has enabled them. What does this mean to you? Can you "work" for your salvation?

14. How does Jesus affirm His disciples in verse 70? How does he affirm you?
