

# **EXHALE Bible Discovery ~ John Chapter 10**

## Day 1: Read Verses 10:1-5

- 1. Verse 1 may appear to be difficult to understand, as you read through verses 1-5, try and explain what you think Jesus meant in verse 1? Who are the thieves and robbers?
- 2. Who is the Shepherd and who are the sheep?
- 3. Who is the Watchman? What is His role?
- 4. What does verse 5 mean to you? Explain why Jesus spoke about the stranger's voice.

## Day 2: Verses 10:6-10

- 5. Find the two "I Am" statements and write them below:
- 6. Why does Jesus describe Himself as "the gate"?
- 7. In verse 10, Jesus says, "the thief comes only to steal, kill, & destroy." Who is the enemy?
- 8. What does Jesus say He came to do?

### Day 3: Verses 10:11- 19

- 9. What does the good shepherd do?
- 10. Explain who the "hired hand" and what does he do? (v 12)
- 11. In verse 16, Jesus says, "I have other sheep, I must bring them also." What does this mean?

12. How did the groups of people respond to Jesus' teachings? (v 19-21)

#### Day 4: 10:22-30

- 13. Verse 22 now tells us where Jesus is at this point. See if you can research some additional information about the Feast of Dedication.
- 14. What argument or facts does Jesus refute the questions asked of Him in verses 25-26)?
- 15. What promise does Jesus tell us about His sheep? (v. 27-30)

#### Day 5: 10:31-42

- 16. Why did the Jews say they were stoning Jesus?
- 17. Go to Psalm 82:6, Exodus 22:28, Deuteronomy 1:17, 16:18, 2 Chronicles 19:6. How do these verses connect to John 10:34?
- 18. After all of this teaching by Jesus, where does He escape to in verses 40-42? What do many people do as a result of Jesus' teachings?

#### **Reflection:**

- 19. How is Jesus leading you in your life as your Shepherd? Share examples.
- 20. Who do you know is from the other sheep pen who need you to tell them about Jesus?
- 21. Sum up this lesson by creating a 10 word sentence that describes this entire lesson.
